



Dear member, we have online entry this year for our **Hillhead Club Championships 2018**. Please read the club championships rules document before entering.

Alternatively you can go to the LTA website - Competitions - Find A Competition - enter tournament code '**WSC18W0245**' in search bar at foot of page.

Please note that the championships rules document is also available online in the 'further details' box on right hand side of main tournament page.

This is a closed event for members of Hillhead Sports Club only and is FREE of charge.

Competitors must be available to play on Finals Day, **Saturday 8th September**. Closing date for entries is **19th June**.

One new entry requirement is that you must have a British Tennis Membership (BTM) number. This is FREE of charge to club members (LITE membership) and can be obtained by following the link: <https://www.lta.org.uk/member/>
(Please ensure you link membership to Hillhead LTC when joining)
Please note when entering the ladies or gents doubles event to enter partner's name in drop down box. When entering mixed doubles, please leave partner's name blank as this is a balloted event.

We strongly encourage you to enter online however the traditional noticeboard entry will be available this year - please have your (and partner's!) BTM number handy if you decide to go with this option.

Draws will be published online **Monday 2nd July**, and during the championships, I will update results online and you will be able to view them on Tournament Software - link will be sent out at beginning of July. On completion of individual matches, winner should enter score on noticeboard draw sheets and text result to myself on 07981 905303.
